**Proposed Traffic Regulation Order ‘No Waiting at Any Time’ restrictions
on various roads in Harpenden**

Hertfordshire County Council proposes to implement ‘No Waiting at Any Time’ (double yellow line) restrictions on specified lengths of the following roads in Harpenden:

- Milford Hill
- Common Lane
- Batford Road
- Lower Luton Road
- Marquis Lane
- Crabtree Lane


These measures are being proposed to facilitate the passage of all vehicles for specified lengths of the roads listed to avoid inappropriate parking in the vicinity of the new Katherine Warington School ensuring the junctions are free from vehicular obstructions and maintain the visibility for all road users.

Appended overleaf is the relevant overview drawing showing the detail and extent in red of what is proposed. I appreciate that the detail on the plan is quite small so should you wish to see enlarged plans of each area please contact me on the above details and I will be happy to send them to you though due to Covid restrictions this may take slightly longer than usual.

The process of implementing waiting restrictions is a legislative and formal one as specified in Law. However, prior to embarking upon that process, it is important and useful to seek your views on what is proposed.
